

#### THE RIGHT TIME FOR THE RIGHT PEOPLE

The most valuable commodity in a modem police department might be one a leader doesn't often consider, at least not in the same way he or she might consider funding or tactical equipment like body armor. Even so, there may be no more important resource than time.

It appears that staffing shortages at U.S law enforcement agencies may be movin from bad to worse. Due to a number of factors, applications are down as much as 9 percent in some departments, exacerbatin an existing scarcity of human resources in the public safety sector.<sup>1</sup>

This could spur a renewed focus on per sonnel management to ensure that as mucl time as possible can be devoted to mean ingful police work, rather than the logistic associated with coordinating and schedul ing the various activities and functions tha accompany the job. #### Easier Scheduling

Court dates are an inevitable part of lifin law enforcement But in many instancevaluable lime can be lost in a cumbersom scheduling process. My Court Calendar, new software program, works to address that issue.

Normally a subpoena is submitted by an officer or deputy sheriff. They pull up an officer's work schedule, 'said Thoma Santarlas, president of My Court Calendar which is headquartered in Norda. 'Onc they meet those hurdles, they have to even trailly get it to a squad sergeant and hand deliver it to the officer or put it in his or her mailbox, who has to sign having received this.'

That is the traditional way. My Court Calendar can shave hours off that approach. "With our system, we've automated it," Santarlas said. "They can look at the work schedule and see when people are on duty, off duty, out of the office. They set a court date. It's informed, instead of picking a court date in the dark."

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The software can also save money. With a base cost to agencies of \$40 for up to 10 users, plus \$4 for each additional user, the service can quickly pay for itself, especially in the case of agencies that rely on private process servers that can charge anywhere

Court appearances are far from the only activity that officers perform in addition to their policing duties. Training and volunteering, for example, also appear frequently on a typical officer's calendar. Public Safety Software Group in California has created three products designed to help agencies better track these kinds of activities.

The Volunteer Integrated Management System (VIMS), released in 2009, is currently in use by close to 100 public safety agencies as a way of housing volunteer information in a central location and coordinating volunteer activities and schedules.

The Off Duty Integrated Scheduling System (ODISS) simplifies the process of announcing, scheduling, and tracking paid special assignments and events. Cost of the service starts as low as \$39 per month.

The newest of the group's services, unveiled this fall, is the 'Braining Integrated Management System (TIMS), which provides a fast and easy way of scheduling training sessions, notifying pertinent staff of opportunities, and monitoring individual training activities.

"It smooths it all out," said Art Femister, owner and founder of Public Safely Software Group. "People are not sending emails all day... There are so many other things you can do with that time... Think of all the services or traks that could be done."

#### Evaluating Performance Evaluations

At one point during his career, Don Cirillo was writing as many as 20 performance evaluations each year. While he enjoyed many of the tasks he performed as a manager, the evaluations became a dreaded annual grind.

"They're not easy," Cirillo said. "You're pitting one officer against another. It's a hard job to do. I was having a hard time thinking of what I wanted to say." Better information from the community, delivered regularly and reliably, can help officers target their efforts more efficiently.

Now as the head of Law Enforcement bivaluations Online, a Wisconsin-based company, Cirillo's using his experience—and some of those less-than-stellar memories—lo make evaluations easier for the supervisors. His company produces two primary tools: a digial manual containing a slew of common phases used in law enforcement evaluations and standardized evaluation forms that reduce writing and make the process more efficient and consistent.

Combined or separate, Grillo said the tools can help supervisors complete evaluations in one-third the time it takes with traditional orunasisted methods. You see the actual phrases and you just grab one and put it in the form, instead of thinking about what to say? Grillo said. 'H just makes your job easier from the standpoint of what you're going to say It gives you ideas."

#### Predictive Policing, Predicting Personnel

Smoother, faster workflows can make a eal difference in the office. They can also make a difference in the field.

Better information from the community, delivered regularly and reliably, can help officers target their efforts more efficiently. Exploring the data around work patterns and caseloads can improve decision making about where officers and investigators spend their valuable hours.








Pictured above, Common Configuration with Volunteer Coordinator(s) managing event requests who enter and broadcast those events to all or some users on VIMS.


